# Western Avenue Update

...and the work continues!

All of the excavating is done, the concrete has been poured and inlets installed. That leaves the brickwork and plenty of what the contractor calls "filler work" - all of the little things that need to be done in order to complete the project. The contractor has been sealing the inlets, installing the edging for the tree pits, working on the electric for the lights on the south side of the street while having one or two guys working on laying the remainder of the bricks. As more of the filler work is completed, more men will be added to the brick laying activity. The sign posts will be installed and line painting should take place over the next two weeks as well. There's still a lot of work to be done.

We have hired Tower Engineering to work on the electric service moves and they will begin the engineering studies to determine the best way to handle a few of the more challenging service moves in the 800 block. Tom Rosselot (our project manager from the Northside Leadership Conference) will be meeting with the Tower Engineering folks to put an action plan together for all of the electric service moves. Yep, we're still moving the utility services from Western to the alley ways behind. Just to be clear, I'll say it again - the utilities will move off of Western.

While crazy ideas and wacky stories continue to swirl around just about every aspect of this project from just about anyone who has ever set foot on Western Avenue - giving me quite a few laughs, I have to come clean about the project - we are on budget and we have not encountered any unexpected problems thus far. I know, it's a shocking revelation but it's absolutely true!

On a serious note, we continue to work on the project and will do so until it's finished. And we will finish the project according to the plans!






