Cocktail Corner

Bronx Cocktail

Shake with cracked Ice:

- 1 oz Plymouth Gin
- 1 oz French vermouth
- 1 oz Italian vermouth

1 barspoonful orange juice Strain into a cocktail glass and garnish with an orange peel. (Attributed to Billy Malloy, Pittsburgh PA)

William "Bill" Boothby, World Drinks and How to Mix Them (1908)

NOTES:

- As always, drink responsibly.
- Although named after the New York City borough, this particular formulation of the Bronx Cocktail was attributed to a Pittsburgher. Go figure.
- Plymouth gin is readily available at the Fine Wine & Good Spirits stores. I've even seen it at the E. Ohio Street location. However, you should feel free to use a London dry gin like Tanqueray, Beefeaters', Gordon's, etc. According to cocktail expert David Woodrich, Plymouth gin was an advertiser in Boothby's cocktail book, which may explain why it was specified.
- For "French" and "Italian" vermouths, read "dry" and "sweet."
- Feel free to fool around with the proportions. For instance, you could cut back on the vermouths and add a bit more orange juice, if you fancy.
